Dr. László Kürti received his Ph.D. in 2006 in Synthetic Organic Chemistry from the University of Pennsylvania. As a graduate student, Dr. Kürti authored the now classic book: "Strategic Applications of Named Reactions in Organic Synthesis." He is currently a Damon Runyon Cancer Research Fellow at Harvard University in the group of Prof. E. J. Corey (Nobel laureate) where he is working on the development of potent antiangiogenic agents inspired by the structure of Cortistatin A. While at Harvard, he co-authored the recent book "Molecules and Medicine" with Dr. Barbara Czako and Prof. E. J. Corey.
