### Keynote Address

**Dr. David R. Tyler**  
University of Oregon

David R. Tyler is part of the pioneering green chemistry group at the University of Oregon. He received Bachelor of Science degrees (in chemistry and mathematics) with Highest Distinction from Purdue University in 1975. He received his Ph.D. degree in June 1979, from the California Institute of Technology. In July 1979, he was appointed assistant professor at Columbia University. In July 1985, he moved to the University of Oregon and was promoted to full professor in 1990. Dr. Tyler's current research interests are in photochemically degradable plastics; the development of new homogeneous catalysis for use in aqueous solution; and femtosecond timescale photochemistry.
