Keynote Address

Dr. David Birney
Texas Tech University

Dr. David Birney has twenty-five years of experience as professor in the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at Texas Tech University. After earning a BA in chemistry from Swarthmore College, he worked for three years in chemical industry before returning to school to earn a PhD from Yale University and then postdoctoral research at UCLA. While at TTU, twenty-two students from Texas, around the country and around the world have earned PhD and MS degrees in his laboratory. Dr. Birney has published 52 research articles in peer-reviewed journals and has received over \$1.7 million in research funding. He has been a visiting professor at the University of Bordeaux and at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH) in Zurich. He has received numerous awards, most notably the Texas Tech University President's Academic Achievement Award for excellence in teaching, research and service.
